Dear participants,

We are pleased to invite you to the 9th Joseph Sandler Research Conference which takes place in Frankfurt/Main for the first time. Joseph Sandler initiated this conference – together with leading psychoanalytic clinicians and researchers. His aim was to build bridges between psychoanalysts who are working mainly in their private offices and those who are engaged in different forms of extra clinical psychoanalytic research in institutions. Joseph Sandler was President of the International Psychoanalytical Association, Freud Memorial Professor at University College London (UCL) and at Hebrew University Jerusalem. He was a senior scientist at the Sigmund-Freud-Institut in Frankfurt/Main between 1986 and 1990.

The last conferences were held at the University College and the Anna Freud Centre in London. They had been organized by the Research Subcommittee for Empirical Research (first Chair: Peter Fonagy, followed by Linda Mayes and now by Stuart Hauser) and the Research Subcommittee for Conceptual Research (Chair: Marianne Leuzinger-Bohleber). This year's conference programme was also conceptualized by both Research Subcommittees. It is devoted to an important and extremely controversial topic: *Early Development and its Disturbances (Psychoanalytic perspective on the development of ADHD and other psychopathologies)* which will be discussed from clinical, conceptual, empirical and interdisciplinary perspectives. Internationally leading speakers and discussants promise a challenging and innovative conference which hopefully will be interesting for psychoanalysts, therapists, medical doctors as well as for teachers, educational and social scientists and practitioners.

Sehr geehrte Damen und Herren,

wir freuen uns sehr, Sie zu der 9. Joseph Sandler Research Conference einzuladen, die erstmals in Frankfurt/Main stattfindet. Joseph Sandler rief – zusammen mit führenden Forschern und Klinikern der internationalen Psychoanalyse – diese Konferenz ins Leben, um den Dialog zwischen klinisch und empirisch Forschenden im Feld der Psychoanalyse zu intensivieren. Joseph Sandler war u. a. Präsident der International Psychoanalytical Association, Freud Memorial Professor am University College London (UCL) und an der Hebrew University Jerusalem. Er war von 1986 bis 1990 Gastwissenschaftler am Sigmund-Freud-Institut. Es war ihm ein Anliegen, Brücken zu bauen zwischen Klinikern, die vorwiegend in ihrer Privatpraxis arbeiten und psychoanalytischen Forschern verschiedenster Ausprägung, die in Institutionen arbeiten.

Die letzten Forschungskonferenzen fanden am UCL und dem Anna Freud Center in London statt und wurden gemeinsam vom Research Subcommittee for Empirical Research (Chairs: zuerst Peter Fonagy, dann Linda Mayes und nun Stuart Hauser) und dem Research Subcommittee for Conceptual Research (Chair: Marianne Leuzinger-Bohleber) organisiert. Auch das diesjährige Programm wird von beiden Subcommittees getragen. Es widmet sich einem relevanten und heute besonders kontrovers diskutierten Thema: Frühe Entwicklung und ihre Störungen. Psychoanalytische Perspektiven zu ADHS und anderen Psychopathologien, das aus klinischen, konzeptuellen, empirischen und interdisziplinären Perspektiven beleuchtet werden soll. Die renommierten, international führenden Vortragenden und ihre Diskutanten versprechen eine innovative und herausfordernde Diskussion, die, so hoffen wir, sowohl für Psychoanalytiker, Therapeuten, Mediziner, Erziehungs- und Sozialwissenschaftler, aber auch für Berufsgruppen in Bildungsinstitutionen interessant sein wird.
