***THE CHALLENGE OF WORKING
WITH PARENTS OF A CHILD
IN PSYCHOTHERAPY***

The Study Day is a half-day seminar organised by the European Federation of Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy (EFPP). Its principal aim is to promote a clinical and theoretical dialogue between the four psychoanalytic Sections under the umbrella of the Federation: adult, child and adolescent, couple and family, and group.

This EFPP C&A Study Day will be based on the clinical work of VERITY EMANUEL, child & adolescent psychoanalytic psychotherapist (ACP – UK).

The presentation of VERITY EMANUEL will draw on her clinical experience of working with parents in the public sector context. It will consider the parent-child relationship as a central aspect of the work of the child psychotherapist; whether parents are physically present in the room, adjacent to the individual work with the child, or absent from the child's external life.
