LEVELS OF CHANGE IN PSYCHOANALYTIC FAMILY PSYCHOTHERAPY

The family therapeutic process invites reflection on change at multiple levels—symptomatic, individual, relational, and transgenerational—and on the difference between visible or temporary improvement and deeper psychic transformation. What does it mean for a family to change? Is the disappearance of a symptom evidence of genuine transformation, or can it conceal a shift in how distress is expressed and contained? This Study Day will explore these questions through the presentation of a family clinical material.
